SUZUKI ON THE MOON

Suzuki's 'go anywhere' 4WD is set to take on the final frontier. The company has joined Team Hakuto to compete for the Google Lunar XPRIZE, the world's first race to land a privately funded spacecraft on the surface of the moon.

16 teams from 10 countries are competing for prizes worth a total of US\$30 million. The goals are to successfully land a spacecraft on the lunar surface, travel 500 metres, and transmit high-definition video and images back to Earth by the end of 2017.

Team Hakuto is made up of about 100 people from venture companies, universities, and a diverse range of other private-sector organisations. Suzuki will play a very important part, lending their unrivalled off-road expertise to help the team overcome the incredible challenges ahead of them:

- An unexplored landscape 380,000 kilometres away
- Temperatures over 100°C during the day and below -150°C at night

- A surface littered with rocks and covered in extremely fine powder

It's the perfect proving ground for Suzuki's all-wheel-drive technology!

One small step...

After receiving the Mobility Milestone Prize for proving their rover will function in the harsh environment of space, Team Hakuto is now considered a frontrunner in the race. Their rover is also one of the most compact and lightweight of all the competitors. While the race is for the moon, the ultimate goal is to spur breakthroughs in mobility, efficiency, improved materials, artificial intelligence and sustainable energy – goals which align perfectly with Suzuki's philosophy.

Suzuki began developing off-roaders in 1968. Perhaps in 2017 we'll see Suzuki vehicles make the next giant leap.

Take a kid fishing



Baleno and Vitara winning hearts – and awards

Both the new Baleno hatch and the expanded range of Vitara compact SUVs are not only finding favour with plenty of new customers, but they are also impressing the awards judges as the latest New Zealand motoring accolades attest.

The Baleno has been named class winner for new cars costing less than \$30,000 in the AMI Insurance/New Zealand Autocar of the Year 2016 Awards. NZ Autocar magazine praised the car's value and added space; "Here is a car that sells for the same money as high-end Swifts but is much roomier inside".

While the Baleno is larger, it weighs less and features a zesty 1.4 litre, 16-valve engine, so NZ Autocar also had good things to say about its pace and economy. "Those with an eye for a bargain shouldn't overlook this surprise from the sub-continent" they said.

Meanwhile the compact SUV Vitara range continues to find favour with motorists, fuelling Suzuki's 44% increase in SUV sales in 2016. Vitara too, received praise being named Small SUV of the Year by both NZ4WD magazine and the business-focussed NZ Company Vehicle.

"Vitara was a real highlight for us", said Gary Collins, General Manager of Marketing for Suzuki New Zealand. "Both the 1.6 litre and the new 1.4 BoosterJet Turbo models are finding a sweet spot with our customers with their style, value for money, easy economical performance and traditional Suzuki SUV talents."

Nine new bikes for 2017

Suzuki unveiled five new motorcycles at the 2016 INTERMOT International Motorcycle Fair held in Cologne, Germany. And four more models were unveiled at the EICMA2016 Milan Show – that's a total of nine new models for 2017!

The most exciting news for supersport riders, is the all-new GSX-R1000AL7. It's the lightest, most powerful and best handling 'Gixxer' ever built with a high spec that

includes multi-mode traction control, ABS, a ride-by-wire throttle, bi-directional quickshifter, an all-new engine, and all-new chassis.

Other new models include the GSX-R125, and the GSX-S750 street sportbike. There's also an all-new line-up of V-Strom adventure bikes that are destined to continue the legend.

Speaking at the Cologne launch Toshihiro

Suzuki, the President of Suzuki Motor Corporation said "Today we are introducing an enhanced model series that can be enjoyed by everyone, from people just starting out on a bike through to veteran riders. Looking ahead, there is much more to come from Suzuki, as we strive to produce refreshing, creative products that exceed expectations in every possible way."



Suzuki wins MotoGP

Suzuki rider Maverick Viñales was a class apart in the 2016 British Grand Prix at Silverstone. After a crash on the opening lap brought out the red flag, Viñales expertly controlled the restart, breaking away from the pack in the early stages. He gradually extended his advantage as his rivals became embroiled in a frenetic scrap behind him.



After 19 laps Viñales took out the historic victory with a winning margin of 3.5 seconds. "It is an awesome feeling," said the 21 year old Spaniard. "For sure, it is the best moment of my career. I'm so happy for the team, because they deserve it."

This marked Viñales' first victory in the premier MotoGP class and Suzuki's first since Chris Vermuelen's Le Mans triumph in 2007.

Viñales and team mate Aleix Espargaro are moving on to rival teams for 2017, replaced by Ducati superstar Andrea Iannone and youngster Alex Rins as Team Suzuki Ecstar continue the quest for the MotoGP world championship title.
